- etc...

Gradually we accept all the things that are lies, and forget the truth. We begin to believe that the Bible is just a guide book open to interpretation. We begin to believe that we are all gods. We forget about Jesus...

The water is boiling and we are dead spiritually!

What can we do to guard ourselves? Pray, read the Bible, and do what the Bible says. We must also watch for the subtle things that take us away from God. When we get the feeling that this is
