- 1) Surprising and strange defeats can always be traced back to secret sins Psalms 139:23-24
- 2) Very private sin can lead to public consequences <u>Hebrews 12:15</u>, <u>Joshua 7:18-19</u>
- 3) Temptations, lies, blinds us to reality and deafens us to the consequences Joshua 7:21
- 4) Sweeping acts of disobedience(sin) calls for severe punishment Joshua 7:25

When we face defeat, we must face the sin that holds us back from following God, then and only then will defeat become a thing of the past. Yet we must not confuse times of testing with defeat. When we follow God and realize the truth, we will never again taste true defeat! Romans 8:31, Psalms 118:5-6
